April 4th and 5th -- We participated in **Deborah meeting**. We had a refreshing time with the MBB sisters. Children actively participated in bible stories and learned new songs. They had fun colouring the bible stories pages and narrating the story, they learned moral values from the story.



April 6th -- Field visit to **Mohana school along with** Dr. Annie and Ms. Ria. We spent some time at the school and interacted with students & staff. Dr. Annie narrated a bible story and Miss. Ria taught them a new action song.



We are planning to start a Deborah meeting every month at the Lucknow center as directed by Dr. Annie. Women will be gathered for a prayer retreat programme.

April 8th & 9th -- We visited the **Ludhiana** Center for a discussion on future plans with Dr. Alex and Mrs. JoyAnn. We discussed phonetics and curriculum development for students. We met Mrs. Shubha and her son Mr. Joshua. We made plans to provide booklets to most of our schools.



April 11th to 16th -- We conducted Teachers training for **BSK Centers at Kachhwa**.

We went to visit a few tuition centers and Mrs. Shubha and Joshua accompanied us.



Mrs.Suman runs this center and we were very pleased to see the progress. Children were able to answer all the questions asked.

This encourages us to move forward.

There were a few other centers who were not able perform properly due different reasons.

But I could definitely see the efforts to improve and press on forward.



These children enjoy learning even near construction sites or in rooms with no roofs. But, still they attend and learn at these tuition centers. Maybe 100% result won't be accomplished right away, but we see some improvement in the learning, which makes us happy travelling through these dusty roads.
